Jacksonville Veterans Memorial Arena

The Jacksonville Veterans Memorial Arena is a 15,000 seat multi-purpose arena in Jacksonville, Florida. Built in 2003, the Arena is home to the Jacksonville Sports Hall of Fame, and has hosted events such as 2006 NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament, Elton John, NFL Superbowl Concert Series, and is the future host of the 2010 NCAA Men's Basketball tournament.

Guestrooms. This 19-story property offers 966 guestrooms with St. John's River or city views. Hyatt Grand Beds feature pillow top mattresses, 250-thread count sheets, down blankets and decorative pillows. Refrigerators are available upon request for a fee. Technological enhancements include MP3 adaptors. Bathrooms feature shower/tub combinations and are stocked with Portico toiletries.



Shuttle Transportation available to & from Jacksonville Veterans Memorial Arena and the Hyatt Regency

All Official Country Member Delegates & Individual Spectators traveling in your group who book rooms at the Hyatt Regency may purchase a shuttle pass for school bus transportation for all 4 competition days at a fee of \$15.00 per person, provided by STUDENT FIRST. Teams may purchase their own private school buses if preferred for a fee of \$165 per bus (for a 3 hour period). Buses seat 44 passengers.

Breakfast and Dinner available

All Official Country Member Delegates & Individual Spectators traveling in your group who book rooms at the Hyatt Regency may purchase a breakfast buffet pass for \$19.00 per person per day: Monday, August 1 through Monday, August 8 and a dinner buffet pass for \$22.00 per person per day for the following 4 days: Wednesday, August 3 through Saturday, August 6.
